



A Draught of a Tract of Land situate in Penns Township Northumberland County. Surveyed the 13th day of November 1790 for Phillip Eveck in pursuance of his Warrant bearing date the 23rd day of April 1773. Containing ninety two acres and 80^{er} & allowance.

Sir:

I some time in December 1791 forwarded the Draught of this land to your honours office and since that time have found it to interfere with a Draught Returned by Mr J. J. Wallis to your office, the interference was in the line of S. 41 E. 30 which should have S. 15 E. 30 p. this is I believe right, and therefore I send it for your honours kind acceptance
