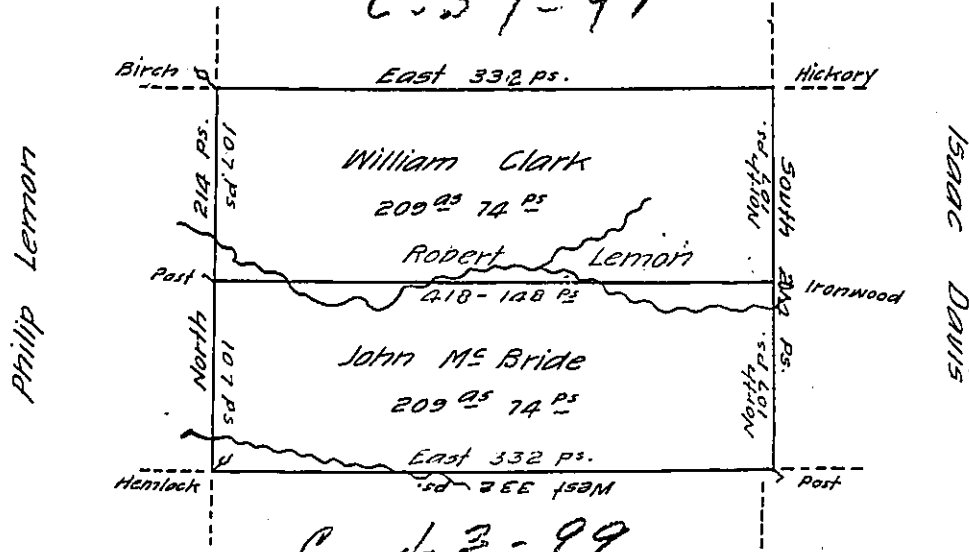

In pursuance of Warrant for 400 acres dated the 10<sup>th</sup> day of April A. D. 1793, was surveyed the Third day of June A. D. 1817 for Robert Lemon the above described Tract of Land containing 418 acres 148 perches and allowance of six per Cent for Roads &c and that the same was divided as above stated - (by Consent) Between William Clark the Assignee of the said Robert Lemon and John M. S. Bride and at the time of making said survey the said John M. S. Bride was in the actual Resident possession of the same with his family and had a house, and there appeared to be upwards of ten acres of Land cleared, fenced and under cultivation - Situate in Cassewago Township Crawford County
