



A Draught of a Tract of Land situate on the south side of Alleghany River on a small Run Emptying into the said river in Westmoreland County Containing three Hundred & Eighteen acres and the usual allowance of Six P. Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 13th of October 1775 in pursuance of a War-
rant issued to Willm Mears out of the Proprietary's Land Office bearing Date Febyuary 28-1774.
