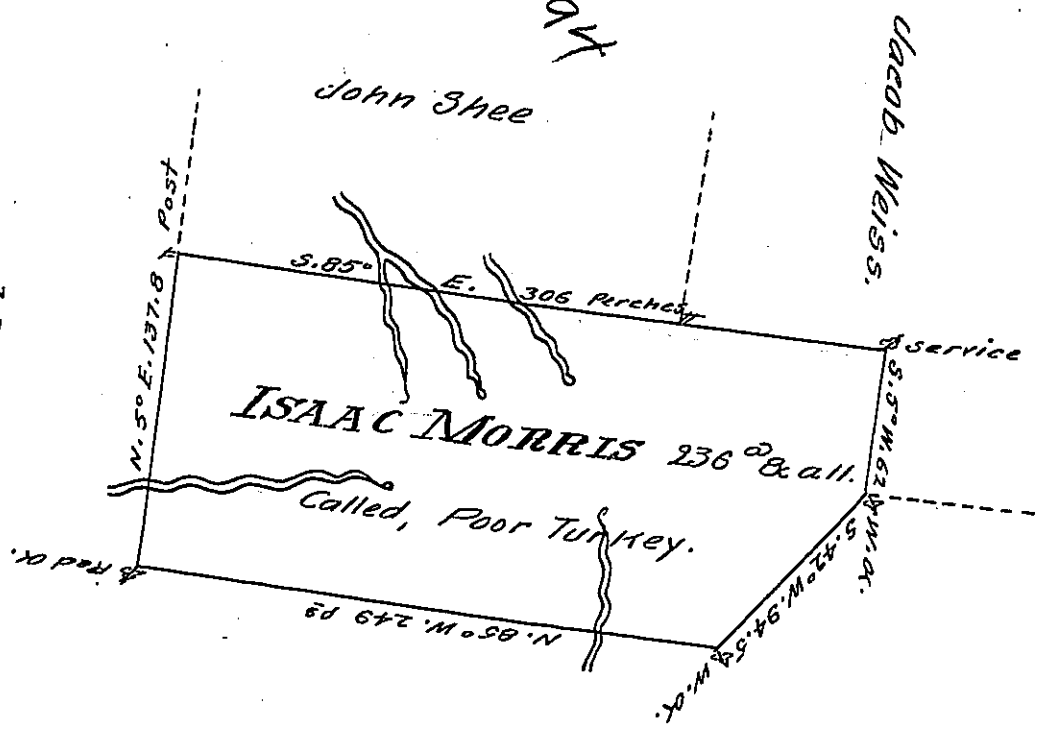

Situated on a Branch of Castlemans River that runs through a glade in the Chestnut Ridge, or Negro Mountain, known by the name of the Negro Glade in Turkey Foot Township Bedford County and Surveyed the 13th and 14th days of June 1776. In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 27th day of March 1775.
