A Draught of a Tract of Land called Spring Grove (being part of a larger Tract of the same Name) situate at the Heads of a Run called Sandy Run & including the Heads of a Run which falls into Stony Creek about 8 Miles above Conemaugh old Town including also the Head Waters of Paint Creek adjoining Lands of John Rohra, Martin Mayli, John Whitmore Junr, Samuel Hess and David Graft in Brother's Valley Township in the County of Bedford Containing three hundred and ten Acres & the usual Allowance of Six P. Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 10<sup>th</sup> & 11<sup>th</sup> Days of May 1774 for Jacob Musser in pursuance of a Warrant Dated the 28<sup>th</sup> Day of December 1773 by
