



A Draught of one hundred and two acres of land with six per Cent for Roads situate in Armagh township Mifflin county - Surveyed 1st April 1799 in pursuance of a Warrant to Samuel ME Rory John Bates & Lewis Studs; dated 19th April 1798. Note, an actual resident settlement was on this land at the time of survey, as appears by official papers remaining in my office, Calculated &c. 7th December 1812.
