



A Draught of thirty six acres and sixty six perches of land with 6-  
 P. C. for Roads which is part of 102<sup>o</sup> surveyed 1<sup>st</sup> April 1799 in pursua-  
 nce of a Warrant to Samuel McRory John Bates and Lewis Studs dated  
 19<sup>th</sup> April 1798 situate in Armaugh township in Mifflin County, and divid-  
 ed the same day, as appears by official papers remaining in my  
 office, Note an actual resident Settlement was on this land at the time  
 of Survey, as appears by the said official papers remaining in my  
 office, Calculated and Drafted 7<sup>th</sup> December 1812.
