



A Draught of Two Tracts of Land Situate in the County of Northampton
 (formerly Bucks) in the Province Pennsylvania That were Surveyed unto Wil-
 liam Morry in Pursuance of one Warrant granted to him by the Honble Pro-
 prietaries Dated on the fourth Day of December Anno — 1751

The first Tract is Situate in Upper Saucon Township and Contains
 Fifty nine acres and fifty perches of Land together with the usual allow-
 ance at Six per Cent for Roads.

And the second Tract is situate in Salisbury Township in the said
 County and Containing Thirty five acres, and 120 perches of Land with the
 said usual allowance for Roads.

Resurveyed for the said William Morry's heirs on the 12 Novem-
 ber Anno — 1766 By Order of the Surveyor General.
