



The above is a Draught of a Survey made Nov. 25th 1830 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Hugh Miller for eight acres dated Feb'y 23d 1828, Containing Five acres and 78 perches and allowance of Six per Cent for highways, situate in Morris Township, Washington County on the waters of Ten Mile Creek. Improved and a Cabin on it, but not occupied at the time of Survey.
