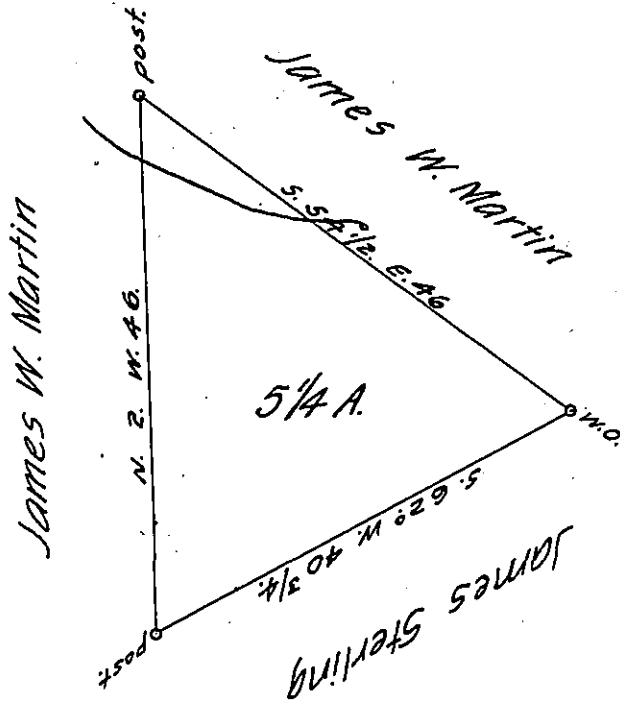


Hanover -
