 ance of a Warrant Granted to Joseph M<sup>c</sup>Gaffen for 400 Ac<sup>s</sup> of Land Dated  
 the 14<sup>th</sup> of April 1792 Situate North and West of the River Ohio, on the West  
 Bank of Big Beaver Creek Adjoining Land Granted to Barnabas M<sup>c</sup>Shane,  
 Called (p-7-2-) Raccoons Dwelling. Containing four Hundred and forty Acres  
 With Allowance of Six  $\frac{1}{2}$  Cent for Roads.
