



The above described tract of land containing one hundred and five acres and one hundred & two perches & allowance proportioned at six per cent. situate in Mountpleasant Township in the County of Westmoreland, was surveyed to Robert McClelland on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of January 1811 in pursuance of his warrant dated September 25<sup>th</sup> 1788 by John Moore then Deputy Surveyor taken from his Draft now in my Office which I have examined & find apparently tollerable correct (December 15<sup>th</sup> 1812.)
