



Situate in Codorus Township in the County of York. Containing as above set forth 28^{2/3} of allowance. Being part of a larger tract of 121^{1/4} and allowance which was originally surveyed by Charles Lukens late D.S. on the 4th day of June A.D. 1772 for Henry Summeraver in pursuance of an order to agree from Richard Hockley Esquire one of the Proprietaries agents, granted to the said Henry Summeraver for 150²⁵ dated the 21st day of May 1772. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract of land the 23rd day of May Anno Domini 1812 at the instance and request of Nicholas Messersmith the present owner who desired the same to be returned for Confirmation
