Originally surveyed to Joseph Martin by Warrant dated the 25 March 1776. Resurveyed and the 20 March 1804 divided between the heirs of Joseph Martin dec'd & the Administrators of 5^d deceased's estate. (The Administrators part is part of 66 acres & 142 perches of land ordered by the Orphans Court to be sold which sale was confirmed the 13 January 1804) Containing five acres one hundred & nine perches & the allowance of six p Cent &c^a
