

Situate in Woodberry township Huntingdon County containing forty two acres & 46 perches and allowance Surveyed the 19th day of November 1811 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to John Miller dated October 18th 1811.—

Note - Whan I surveyed this land a considerable part of it was cleared and under good fence, the house Showin to me was an old Cabin with no foof nor door neither Chunk, a nor Daub, a about 12 by 16 feet in the Logs & about six feet high a log cut out of the side whereat a person might go in Ing Morrison D.S.
