

The above draught is that of a tract of land which was surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to Samuel Miller & containing four hundred and one acres twenty four perches and the allowance of six  $\frac{1}{2}$  c<sup>t</sup> &c.

Situate N.W. of the Allegheny River and now in Sugar Creek Township Armstrong County bounded by lands surveyed in pursuance of the respective warrants of John Miller Thomas Elder June and Robert Barr and land settled by John Snow as represented by the diagram and which is the same tract of land which Matthew Smith by deed dated Aug<sup>t</sup> 10 AD 1830 did convey to Arch<sup>d</sup> McCall of the City of Philadelphia all his right and interest thereto -- as an actual settler
