



About the 9th or 10th of April AD 1830 Resurveyed the above described tract of land for the present owner Matthew Rankin containing two hundred and seventy one acres, One hundred and twenty one perches and the allowance of six p^c 6^t 6^c. Situate in Plum Creek Township Armstrong County bounded by lands of John S. Woodward and Alexander Clark Esq^r and the original surveys of Joseph Dunlap and Robert Cooper. being the Western part of the same tract of land which was surveyed to Christopher McMichael and James Clark in pursuance of two Warrants, one of which was granted to Christopher McMichael and the other to James Clark, the latter is dated Aug^t 24th AD 1786 and appears to have been intended for the part of the land above represented by the draught
