



This small tract of land marked C.D. is situated in Elizabeth Township Allegheny County joining the located tract of John Perry's and was surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 5th day of March 1787. Granted to William Moore said to contain 50 acres but falls short which land has since been divided between Thomas Drennen Senior and Thomas Drennen Junr. The part C fell to Thomas Drennen Junior for which a patent has issued containing some better than 36 acres. the part D fell to the share of Thomas Drennen Senior yet unpatented but is desirous of having it patented. It contains twelve acres and forty five perches and allowance of six per cent inclosed with black lines resurveyed the 7th of May 1830 by
