Containing as above set forth 69⁴⁵ 24 perches and allowance $\frac{1}{2}$ per cent being part of a larger tract of Land which was originally surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to Daniel McLoughery dated the 31st day of October 1745. Resurveyed and Divided off from the said larger tract on the 12th day of March 1824. and now this 1st day of April 1828 the same is returned for confirmation at the request of John Wagoner the present owner
