



A draught of a tract of land called — situate on the North West side of the East Branch of Susquehanna — and in a valey on the North West side of Shawanese Town Mountain on the waters of a creek called Falls Creek which empties into the said East Branch below Shawanese Town at Wioming in the County of Northamperland containing three hundred & one acres & three quarters of an acre besides the usual allowance for roads & <sup>ts</sup> at six p cent Surveyed the 12<sup>th</sup> day of August 1775 for Joseph Mifflin in pursuance of a warrant dated the 10<sup>th</sup> day of May 1773.
