

Adraught of a tract of land called—situate on the North West side of the East Branch of Susquehanna—and in a valey on the North West side of Shawenese Town Mountain on the waters of a creek called Falls Creek which empties into the said East Branch below Shawanese Town at Wioming in the County of Northamperland containing three hundred & one acres & three quarters of an acre besides the usual allowance for roads & the atsix p cent Surveyed the 12th day of August 1775 for Jose ph Mifflin in pursuance of a warrant dated the 10th day of May 1773.
