



Situate about a mile & a half from the Warm Springs in Barree township Huntingdon County containing 133° 38' prs. & the usual allowance of six per cent for roads surveyed the first day of May 1793 in pursuance of a warrant to Alexr May for 400 acres dated the 6th day of May 1788.

Note the remainder of the land Alexander Mays Warrant calls for has been surveyed and returned to Thomas Long on his warrant dated the 2^d day of November 1784 and this survey must include the improvement mentioned in Mays warrant which is said to be a small Deadning there being no kind of Improvement on the above 133° 38' prs.
