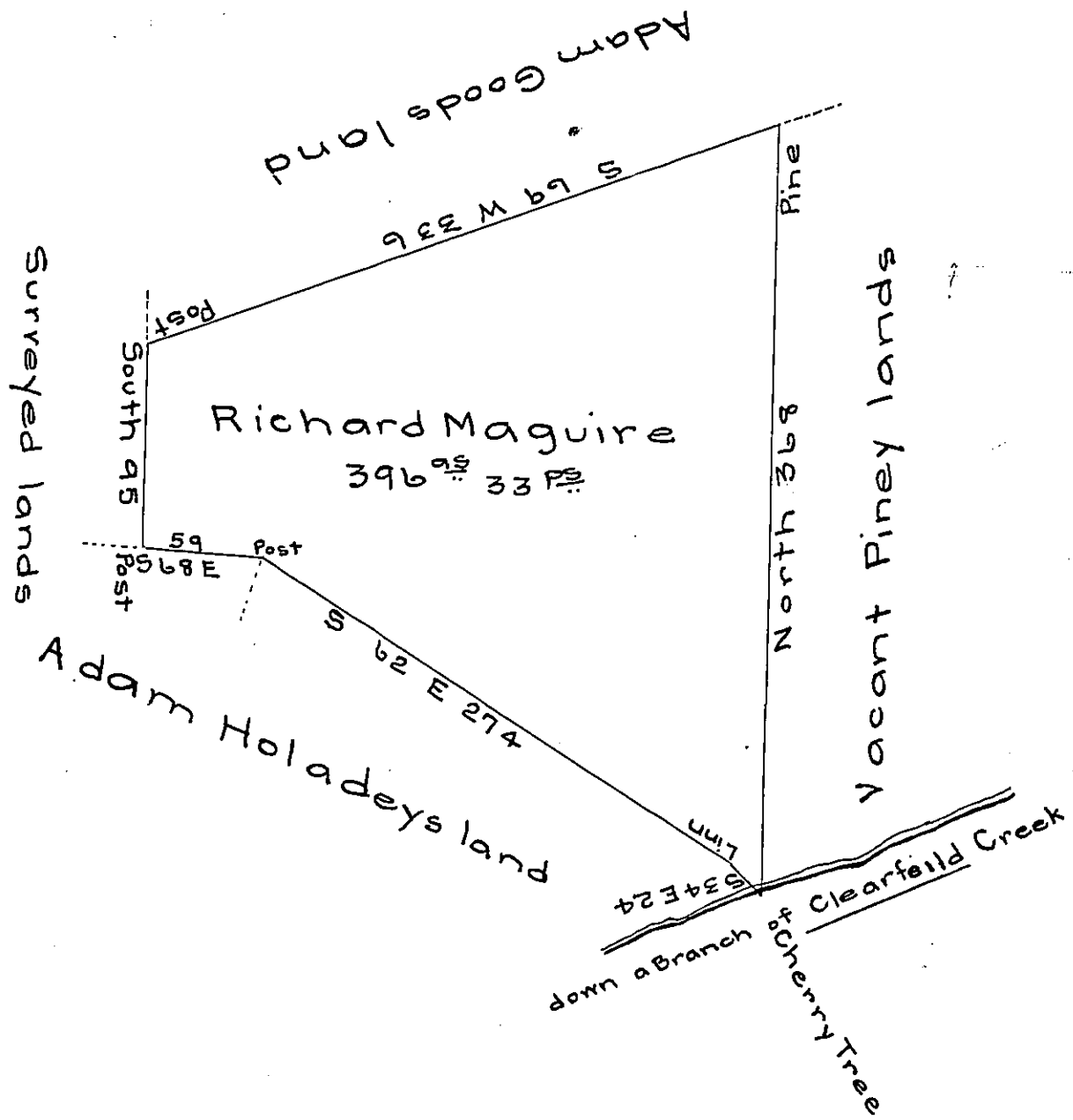

NOTE also the survey above referred to was Ret^d into ye Secretarys Office for Patenting the 1st March 1790 -
