1787 in pursuance of a warrant granted to William  
McFarland, dated Feby 23<sup>rd</sup> 1786. The land is situated  
on the waters of the middle Fork of Tenmile Creek  
in Washington County and contains three hundred  
and two acres, ~~three rods & sixteen perches~~  
with allowance of 6 pr. cent call<sup>d</sup>. Delay.
