



27th of November A.D. 1850 surveyed to William Mitchell and James Mitchell the above described tract containing thirty three acres and allowance consisting of two different surveys the first survey was made the 19th day of November A.D. 1814 by virtue of a warrant granted to James Mitchell (the elder) dated the 26th day of October A.D. 1814 and (marked) returned for 30^{as} & 16 perches & allowance and according to my calculation from actual survey 30^{as} & 32 per & allowance leaving (ob) the dotted triangular interference the second survey of which it is composed is of the same date with this the return of which accompanies this and contains two acres and one hundred and thirty seven perches & allowance by virtue of a warrant granted to James Mitchell dated the 10th day of June A.D. 1850 situate in Blacklick township Indiana county (nearly bordering on Centre township.)
