



A draft of a tract of land situate in Chillisquette township Northumberland county originally surveyed on the 29th day of June 1785 for Benjamin Taylor by virtue of his application N^o 3738 bearing date the 21st day of August A.D. 1769. The above part thereof resurveyed for John Murray on the 18th day of March A.D. 1851 containing seventy seven acres and one hundred and forty six perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c.

N.B. About 45 acres thereof, has been improved say 50 years.
