



In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the twenty-fourth day of February 1785, intitled, 'An act for directing the Mode of distributing the Donation-Lands promised to the Troops by this Commonwealth', and by Order of the Surveyor-General, with the Approbation of the Honourable the Executive-Council, I have surveyed, on the twenty fifth day of November 1785, the above described tract of two hundred acres of land, and allowance of six per cent for roads, &c. N<sup>o</sup> 1232 situate in District N<sup>o</sup> b, on the West side of the Allegheny river, in the County of Westmoreland.
