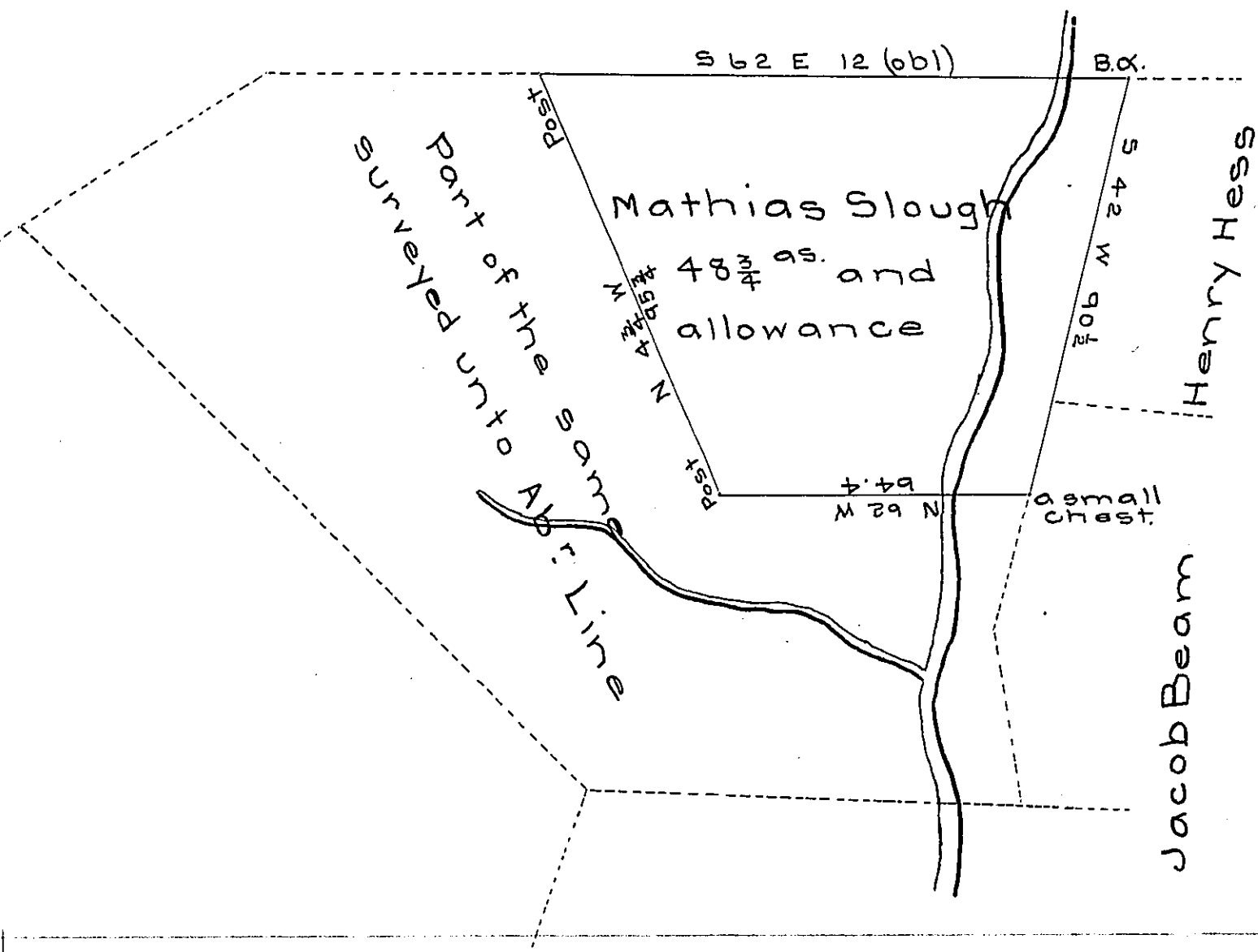


Land late of Samuel Hess Decd

Adraught of a piece or tract of land situate in Conestogo Township Lancaster County containing $48\frac{3}{4}$ as. & allowance of six per cent for roads &c^a surveyed the 21st day of August A.D. 1792 for Mathias Slough (in right of the Heirs of Samuel Meyer Decd) It being part of a larger tract of $144\frac{7}{8}$ as. & allowance surveyed unto the said Samuel Meyer Decd By virtue of a warrant dated the 15th day of March A.D. 1749.
