 & Returned into the Surveyor Generals office, but afterwards, a certain Samuel  
 Malthollam Complained that said Survey included about 20<sup>ac</sup> by him Claimed  
 and for which he had obtained a Warrant dated the 25<sup>th</sup> day of May A. D.  
 1789. Therefore the above alteration was made and sd 20<sup>ac</sup> left out by consent  
 of the Parties interested, and who humbly requested that the Surveyor General  
 would be pleased to except the Return. Accordingly &c<sup>s</sup>
