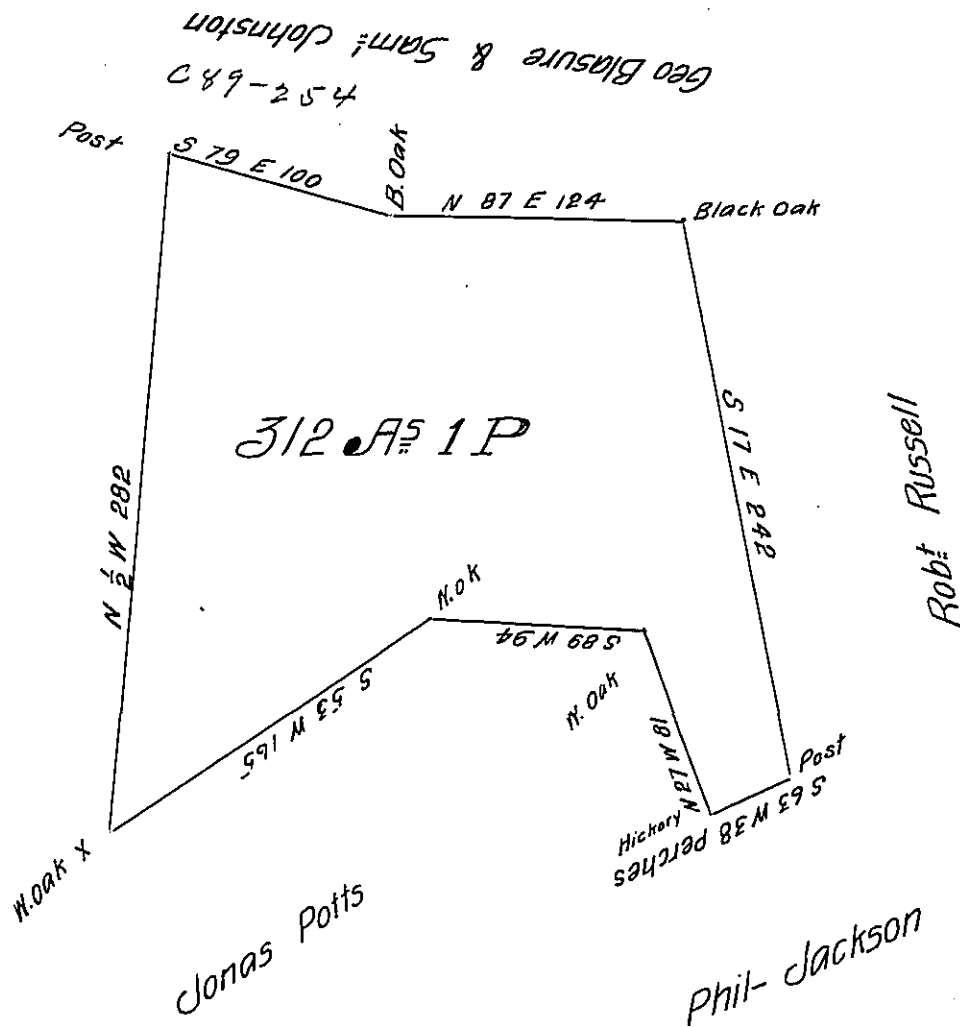

The above is a draught of a tract of land situate in Washington County on the Waters of Kings Creek. Was Surveyed the 20<sup>th</sup> day of August A. D. 1798. In pursuance of an Order of the Honourable the Board of Property (of the 8<sup>th</sup> day of December 1797) and also in Pursuance of a Warrant of Resurvey to me directed by the Surveyor General of Pennsylvania bearing date the 9<sup>th</sup> day of December 1797. Which sd Warrant of Resurvey was annexed to the said Order of the Board of Property, and was allowed to Samuel Marquis by Virtue of a Warrant grated to him and David Dunaldson bearing date the 29<sup>th</sup> day of September 1785 (The sd Samuel Marquis being seized in fee of sd David Dunaldson's right of sd Warrant. Containing 312 acres & one perch & allowance.
