



Whereas there has been a Cavat entred by Samuel Marquis-against a Survey made on a Warrant in the name of James Cook-bearing date December 22^d 1785. Said Warrant dated August 6th 1784. Now ye that We Samuel Marquis- and James Cook-have amicably agreed and setteled the dispute so that said Cavat is hereby lifted and don-away and a Patant to isue for the above draught. Containing ~~one hundred~~ three hundred and twelve acres and one perch and allowance Where unto We have Interchaineably set our hands this 20th day of October 1797 in presence of
