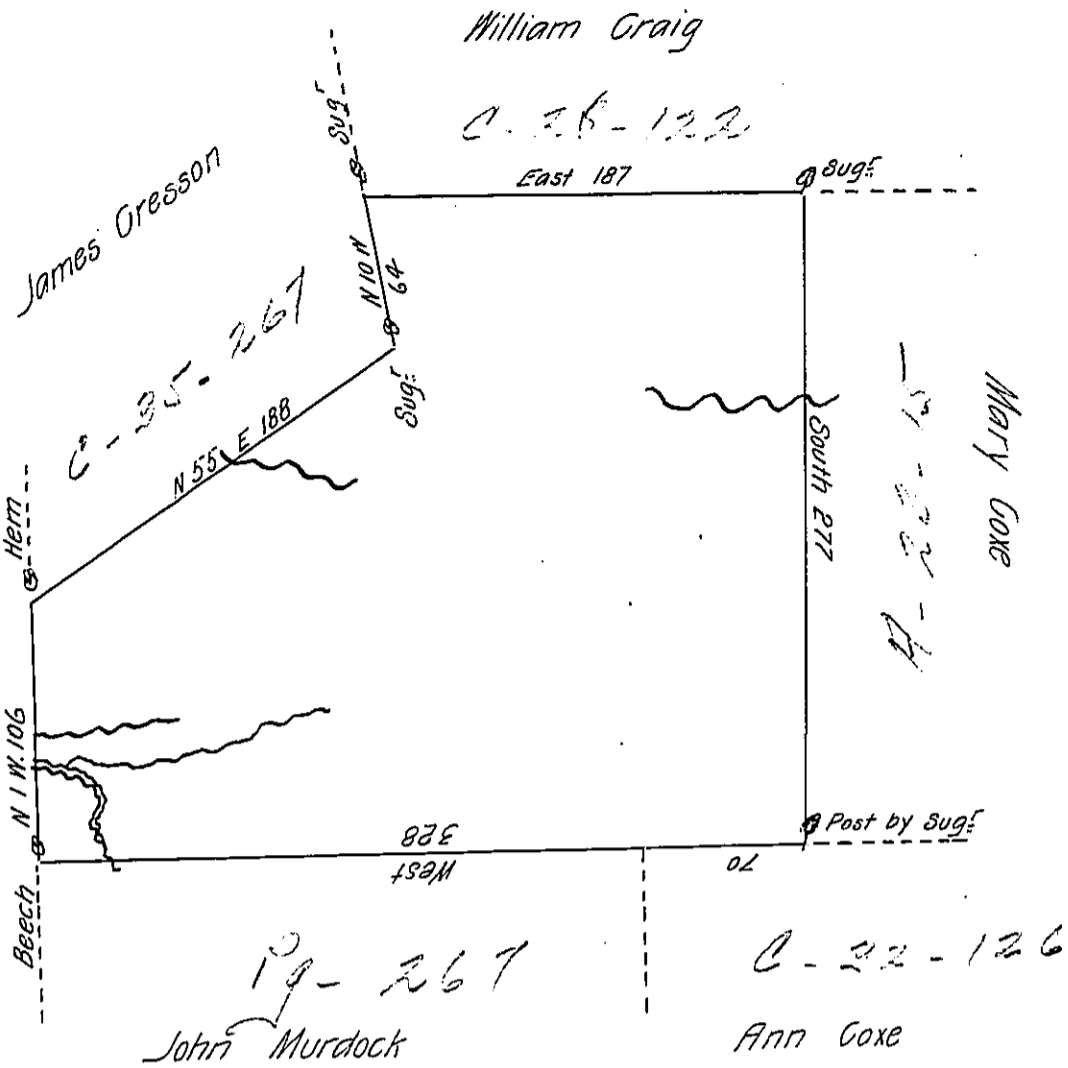


Said to be Surveyed for Israel Morris & Charles Hurst under old Rights
