



In pursuance of a Warrant for 400 Acres of Land dated 8th of June 1796 was Surveyed the 10th of February A.D. 1816 for William Head the above described tract of Land containing 436^{as} 51 perches and Allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. Situate on the West of and adjoining French Creek about two miles above the mouth of Woodcock Creek in Venango Township Crawford County Pa it being the same tract of Land which was Surveyed on the 6th day of October 1794 for Jacob Hawks including his Improvement bearing date to the 10th day of April 1793 and that it clearly appears that said Improvement annexed to the use and benefit of William Head or his assigns and at the time of making said Survey there appeared to be more than 10 acres cleared and fenced a house & Joseph Woodworth was in possession erecting a sawmill for the use of James Foster who appears to be the present claimant.
