


James 177^o. Narby



The above is a draught of a tract of land called Aberdeen, situate on the waters of Milling Creek in Nottingham township Washington county containing two acres and two perches with the usual allowance. Surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted James 177^o. Narby dated 7th of ~~November~~ March 1817 and executed October 28th 1817 —
