


Warrant No. Survey P-128
UPP'RANT of Cumberland
David T. T. Gandy



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Anttrim Township in Cumberland County Containing Two Hundred and Seventy Nine Acres and one fourth Part of an Acre and the usual Allowance of Six P Cent for Roads. Surveyed for Thomas Nisbett the 26th Day of February 1765 in Pursuance of the Honourable the Proprietaries Warrant Bearing Date September 20th 1765

To John Bullock Esq; John Armstrong U.S.
Surveyor General
Returned into the Secretary's Office the 1st day of November 1765 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to said Nisbett to accept this Survey dated the 1st of November 1765.
