



In pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1872 a Survey was made on the 3^d of July following of a certain lot of ground in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in the general Plan of said Town one hundred and forty six and granted to George North Esq. containing in Breadth East and West sixty feet and in length North and South two hundred and thirty feet bounded by Lot number one hundred and forty seven to the Westward, Southward by Dewberry Street Eastward by Lot number one hundred and forty five and Northward by Strawberry Alley as by the general Plan of said Town remaining in the Surveyor General's Office will appear.
