



A draft of a piece of land situate in Mifflin Township in the County of Cumberland containing forty four acres 136 perches & the allowance of six P cent for roads &c Survey'd 9th April 1800 in pursuance of a warrant granted to James McFarlane bearing date 16th December 1799

The above described piece of land is also claimed by John McFarlane (son of the said James) who has obtained a warrant for 200 acres of land on the East and to include the above piece dated 3^d April 1800 which warrant had not come to hand at the time of making the above survey the land is nearly all cleared and is said to have been in the possession of James McFarlane 20 years ago. I run the lines on the East side adjoining John McFarlane as near as possible to the places pointed out as the old boundary between the Father & Son
