The above is the draught of a tract of land called formerly and hereafter to be known by the name of Clearfield Sleeping Place situate on Clearfield Creek on both sides but mostly below the old Trading Path leading from Frankstown to Kittanning &c including one of the Clearfields adjoining and above land surveyed for Geo Craig in Cumberland County containing two hundred and ninety two acres one hundred and thirty seven perches and the usual allowance of six per cent for roads &c surveyed the 29th day of June 1769 for William McDonald in pursuance of an order No 3002 dated April 8th 1769
