



Survey'd to John Nicholson on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of July 1787, the above described tract of three hundred & eighty four acres & a quarter of an acre & allowance of Six P. Cent. Situate adjoining a Survey above the quaking asp Swamp about three miles, including a red Spring south of a branch of Two Lick, about three or four miles from land applied for by Rebecca Barr, in Westmoreland County. By warrant of the 28<sup>th</sup> day of July 1784.
