



January 7th 1836 (obl) above draft represents a survey (obl) made including the actual settlement and improvement of Rev^d Andrew McDonald situate in Logstown bottom Hopewell Township, Beaver County containing Two hundred & fifteen acres ninety six perches and allowance of 6 pr. Ct. adjoining with other lands of said Andrew McDonald on the west, with W^m. McDonald on the south the Ohio River on the east George Baker Tenant on the North, being the same tract of land, represented in a former Book of entries page 214 dated April 28th 1828, being a resurvey, by order of the Board of property, which said tract (agreeable to said entry) was formerly granted to Martin Laughman by the proprietary Government application No 256 dated 3rd April 1769. The three dotted lines on the south end of the above survey represent twenty eight acres surveyed of the tract originally Martin Laughman; to W^m. McDonald in accordance with the last Will &c. of John McDonald Deceased Father to said W^m. and Andrew McDonald; The above line S. 87 1/2 E. 89 perches being a part of the division line adjusted and settled with the approbation of five (obl) appointed by the Orphans Court of Washington County Pa. as directed by the said ~~will~~ Will in case of disputes among his children; the above is a copy of the entry off the Survey Book of entries in and for the county of Beaver, in my office South Beaver Township
