Sir) At the instance of Wm. McDonald and Andrew McDonald of Logs Town Bottom Hopewell Township Beaver County.

I have surveyed the above described Land, being the same tract of Land resurveyed by Henry Davis on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of April 1828 then the D.S. for the County of Beaver; by order of the Board of Property dated (as appears by the Book of surveys) the 3<sup>d</sup> of March 1828, and also appears that the said tract of Land was granted to Martin Laughman by the proprietary Government Appl. No 256 dated 3<sup>rd</sup> of April 1769, after Laying off the above Lot of 28 acres and allowance of 6 pr. Ct. for roads &c. there remains for said Andrew McDonald 215 acres & 96 perches & allowance; but including the above 28 acres &c. making in the whole survey as formerly; 243 acres 96 perches and allowance &c. and being requested by said McDonalds to make return to your office; given under my hand ~~his~~ at South Beaver Township, Beaver County the 16<sup>th</sup> Feb<sup>y</sup>. 1836
