Sir) At the instance of Wm. McDonald and Andrew McDonald of Logstown Bottom Hopewell Township Beaver County.

I have surveyed the above described Land, being the same tract of Land re-surveyed by Henry Davis on the 28th day of April 1828 then the D.S. for the County of Beaver, by order of the Board of Property dated (as appears by the Book of surveys) the 3^d of March 1828, and also appears that the said tract of Land was granted to Martin Laughman by the Proprietary Government Appl. No 256 dated 3^d. of April 1769, after laying off the above Lot of 28 acres and allowance of 6 pr. Ct. for roads &c. There remains for said Andrew McDonald 215 acres & 96 perches & fallowance; but including the above 28 acres &c. making in the whole survey as formerly; 243 acres 96 perches and allowance &c. and being requested by said McDonalds to make return to your office; given under my hand this at South Beaver Township, Beaver County the 16th Feby. 1836
