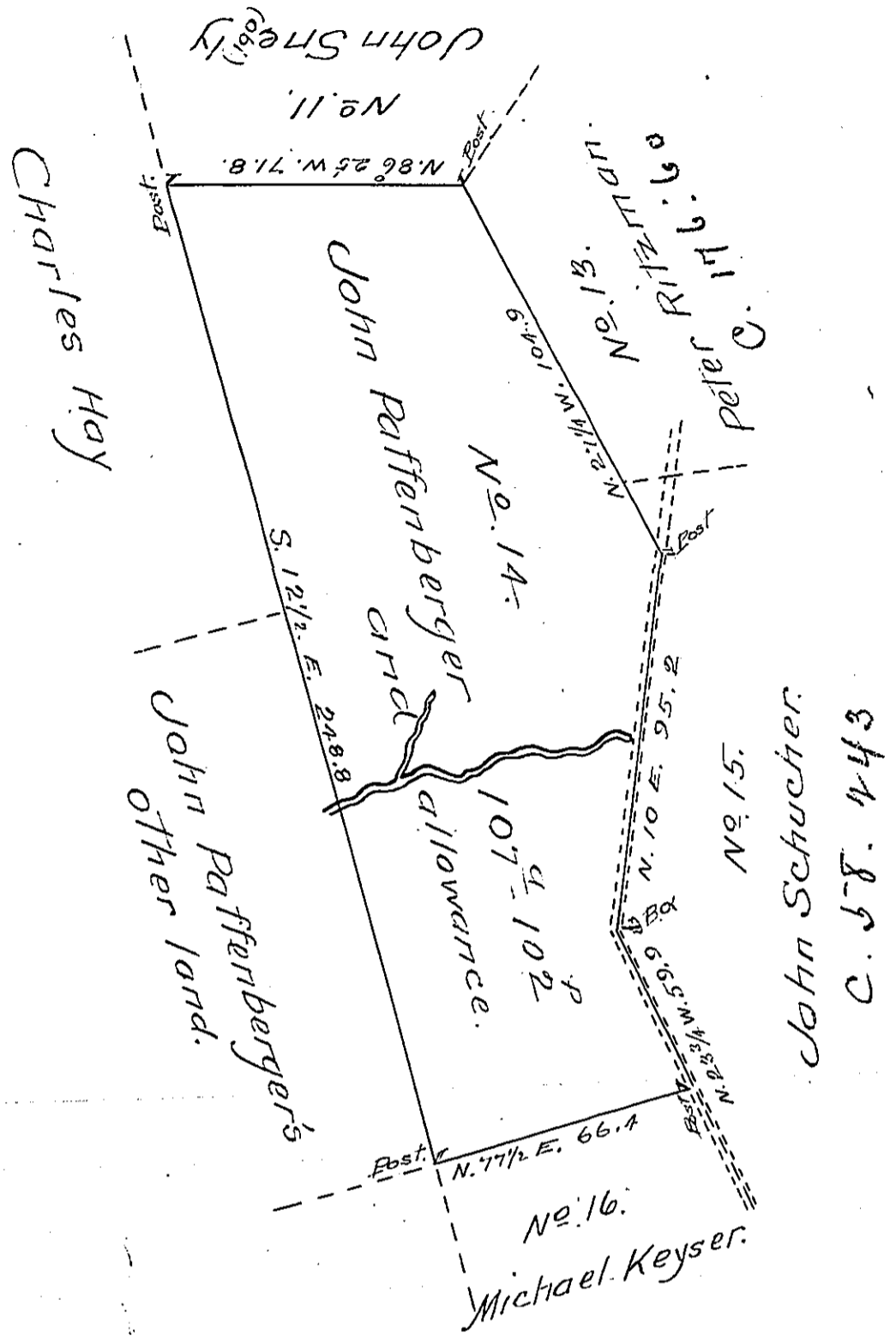

A Draught of one hundred and seven acres and one hundred and two perches and allowance of 6 1/2 Cent fers. being part of a strip of Land cutt off from the Honble Richard Penns Manor at Tulpehoccon in Berks County and Numbered in a General Plan of the same No 14 Returned into the Secretarys Office the 26th day of October 1770 for John Paffenberger by Warrant dated the 18th Instant.
