



In Pursuance of a Warr^t. granted to Mary Peart bearing date the 27th day of July 1772 Requiring me to Survey & lay out for her a lot of Ground in the City - appertenant to - The Original purchase of five hundred Acres made of the Hon[']ble Proprietary W^m. Penn Esq^r. by Richard Collet. I did on the 11th day of Aug^t. following Survey & lay out the above described Lot Situate between 5th & 6th Streets from Delaware and on the North side of Sassafras Street Containing in Breadth Ninety nine feet and in length three hundred and six feet Bounded Westward and Northward with Vacant Ground Eastward by Ground Enclosed by the Representatives of Nicholas Scull dec^d and Southward by Sassafras Street aforesaid - Returned into the Secretarys Office the 12th day of August 1772 -
