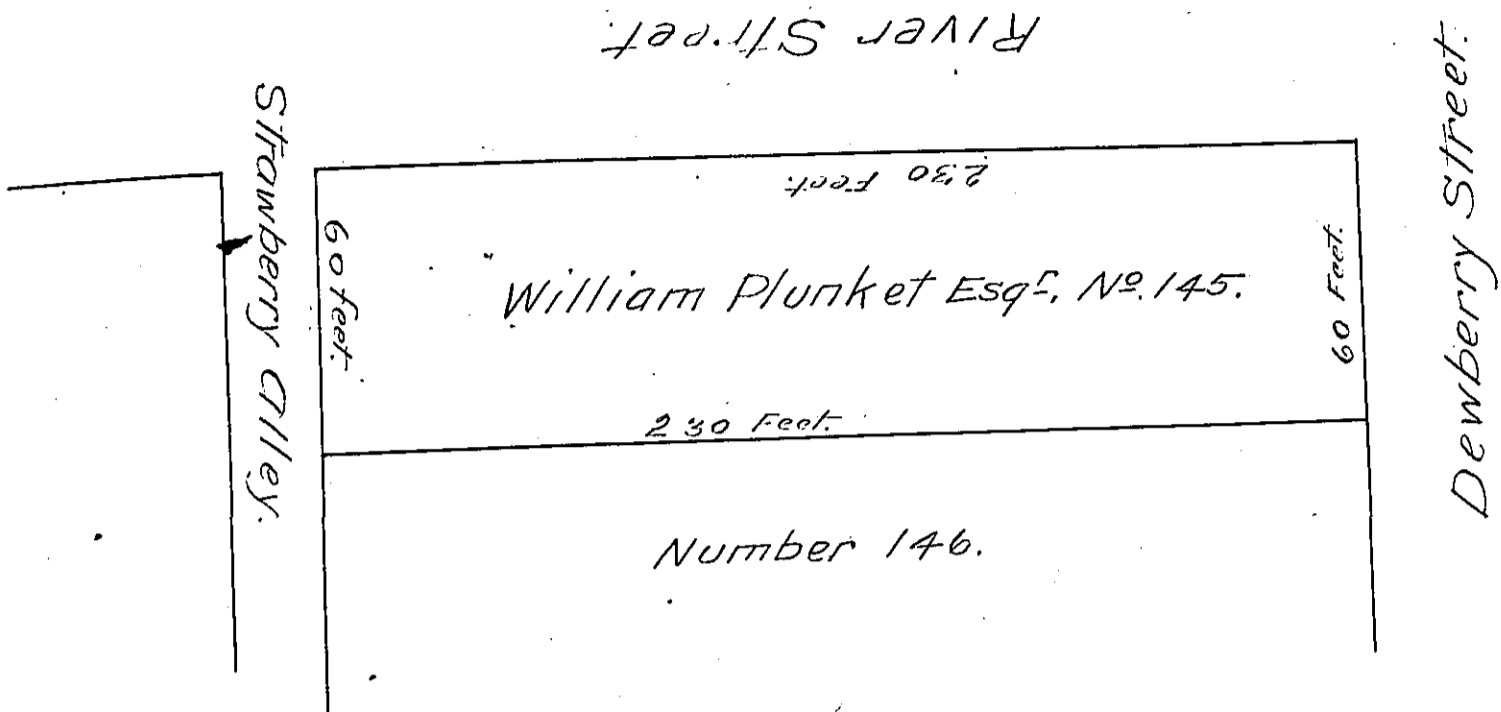

In pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June 1772 a survey was made on the 3<sup>d</sup> of July following of a certain Lot of Ground in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in the general plan of said Town One hundred and forty five and granted to William Plunket Esq. containing in breadth East and West Sixty feet and in length North and South Two hundred and thirty feet bounded Westward by Lot No. 146 Southward by Dewberry Street, Eastward by River Street & Northward by Strawberry alley, as by the general Plan of said Town remaining in the Surveyor General's Office will appear.
