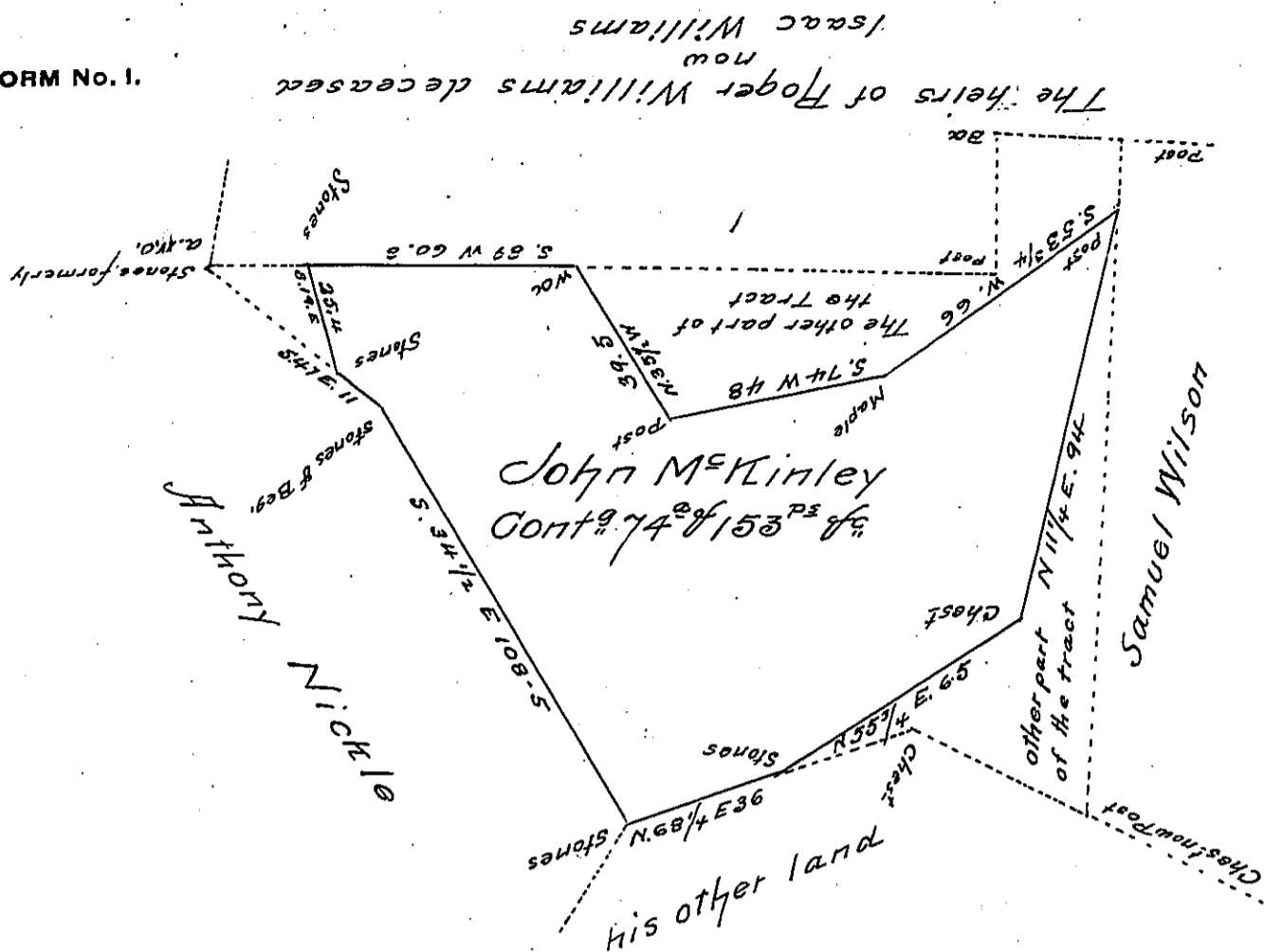


FORM No. 1.



Situate in Chanceford Township in the County of York containing as above set forth 74 1/2 of 153 perches and the usual allowance &c. Being part of a larger Tract of 96 1/2 of 94 perches and allowance &c. of land which was Originally surveyed by William Mathews late D.S. on the 2^d of the 5th Mo. 1770. in pursuance of the application N^o 5387 for 150^a dated the 27th day of March A.D. 1769 granted to John M^c Kinley. Resurveyed by the old lines and divided off from the said larger tract of Land on the 3^d day of May A.D. 1815 for and at the request of James Murphy the owner who desired the same to be returned for Confirmation.
