



A Draught of a Tract of Land situate in Hamilton Township Franklin County containing Forty one acres and fifty four perches and the usual allowance of Six pr Cent for roads. being parts of two Original Surveys Viz -

No 1 is part of a tract of Two hundred and fifty one acres and Seventy one perches & allowance &c. which was surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted to David Black dated October 4th 1738. No 2 is part of a tract of Three hundred and Sixteen acres and the usual allowance &c. which was surveyed in pursuance of a Warrent granted to Samuel Moorehead dated December 15th 1768.
