



By Virtue of a Warrant dated at Philadelphia on the 25th day of May Anno 1756 granted to George Oahldwine (alias Olewine.) The above described Two Tracts of Land Situate in Upper Milford Township in the County of Philadelphia and Province of Pennsylvania. The first containing Eleven acres 85 perches and the usual allowance - and the other contains Eight and one half Acre - and the allowance. Together - Twenty Acres and ~~five~~ perches of Land together with the usual allowance at six per Cent for roads. Were surveyed for the said George Oahldwine on the 20th day of October Anno 1756 - By order of Mr William Parsons Esquire
