



By Virtue of a Warrant granted for 300 acres dated July 1<sup>st</sup> 1784 surveyed the 5<sup>th</sup> of September 1792 unto Stephen Oliver the above described Tract of Fifty four acres and 38 perches of Land & usual allow<sup>s</sup>. The residue of said Warrant could not be laid by reason that it had been previously appropriated to Joseph Wilson on a Warr<sup>t</sup> dated 30<sup>th</sup> September 1773. Situated about one mile from Bozlys mill on a small branch of Chilisquaque Creek then in Mahoning Township North<sup>th</sup> County
