



Situate on the waters of Dunning's Creek St. Clair Township Bedford County Containing One hundred and three acres and thirty eight perches and the usual allowance of six per cent for roads &c being part of a larger tract of land containing 264²; 40^{ps} falls.

Surveyed formerly to George Meade in pursuance of a warrant dated the 3rd June 1763, and Resurveyed and divided for Ann Hoover widow in right of Geo. Meade the 6th June 1831.
